## CEANOTHUS

*Ceanothus thyriflorus* 'Cool Blue' PP24884

Unique variegated form of Ceanthus 'Skylark', with a more compact, upright habit ideal for smaller spaces. This west coast native blooms later than other types, extending the season for pollinators.
